
[Reading the display]

[Time display] [Calendar display] [Seconds display] [Press (Auto-return) The calendar display will automatically return to the time display in two seconds. [Seconds display] Press (Auto-return) Month Date Seconds Seconds

[Readjusting errors up to ±30 seconds]


Precise time can be maintained by correcting the seconds once a month on a time signal from a radio, TV, telephone, etc.



Press (B) in seconds display on a time signal within 30 — 59 seconds.

Press (B) to complete and press (A) or (B) on a time signal.

[Setting time and calendar]



- * Press the ® button with a pointed object such as a pen or pencil.
- ** Check whether the AM (A) or PM (P) indicator is lit.
- *** If correction of minute digits is not required, press (B) to retrieve normal timekeeping.

(Independent correction) Correction of any digit, if not required, can be skipped by pressing the ® button repeatedly. (Automatic digit advance) When the ® button is kept depressed for more than two seconds, the digit advances automatically. When released, the digit advance will stop.
