



(Auto-retrieve function) Daily alarm and Time/calendar setting modes will automatically return to the regular timekeeping mode in 1 or 2 minutes.


[Setting daily alarm]

If the daily alarm is set, the buzzer sounds for 20 seconds at the preset time every day. To stop the buzzer, press the © button. If the time signal is set, the watch sounds one second every hour on the hour. (Sound demonstration) Press and hold the ® button in alarm mode to sound the buzzer.




(Quick digit advance) When the @ button is pressed for more than 2 seconds, the digit advances quickly. When released, the digit advance will stop.

[Presetting dual time]




The dual time mode works in a 24-hour format.


[ON or OFF setting of daily alarm and time signal]

Press ® to complete.

(Quick digit advance) When the ® button is pressed for more than 2 seconds, the digit advances quickly. When released, the digit advance will stop. (Independent correction) Correction of any digit, if not required, can be skipped by pressing the © button repeatedly. (Reversion to regular timekeeping mode) The watch reverts to the regular timekeeping mode if the ® button is pressed, regardless of the digit setting mode. (Auto-retrieve function) When setting the watch, if you leave it alone for 1 to 2 minutes, the display will automatically return to the regular timekeeping mode.

^{*}Precise time can be maintained by correcting the seconds once a month on a time signal from a radio, TV, telephone, etc.
